ASH WEDNESDAY.

Ash Wednesday is the first day of <u>Lent</u> in <u>Western Christianity</u>. It occurs 46 days before <u>Easter</u> and can fall as early as February 4 or as late as March 10. Ash Wednesday is observed by many Western Christians, including Anglicans, Lutherans, Methodists, Presbyterians, and Roman Catholics.

According to the canonical gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke, Jesus Christ spent 40 days fasting in the desert, where he endured temptation by Satan. Ash Wednesday derives its name from the practice of blessing ashes made from palm branches saved from the previous year's Palm Sunday, and placing them on the heads of participants to the accompaniment of the words "Repent, and believe in the Gospel" or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return".

Our Ash Wednesday service will begin at 6:45pm on Wednesday, March 1.

- f) Talbott Elementary School will use our church facility as an off-site evacuation location in the case of a crisis.
- g) Elder Lonnie Knight elected delegate to spring meeting of Presbytery of East Tennessee meeting on April 1, 2017 at 9:00AM with the Shiloh CP congregation. Elder Allen is alternate delegate.

The next session meeting will be Sunday, March 12, 2017 at 5:30pm.

The minutes were read and approved. Closed in prayer by Elder Jim Rolen.
